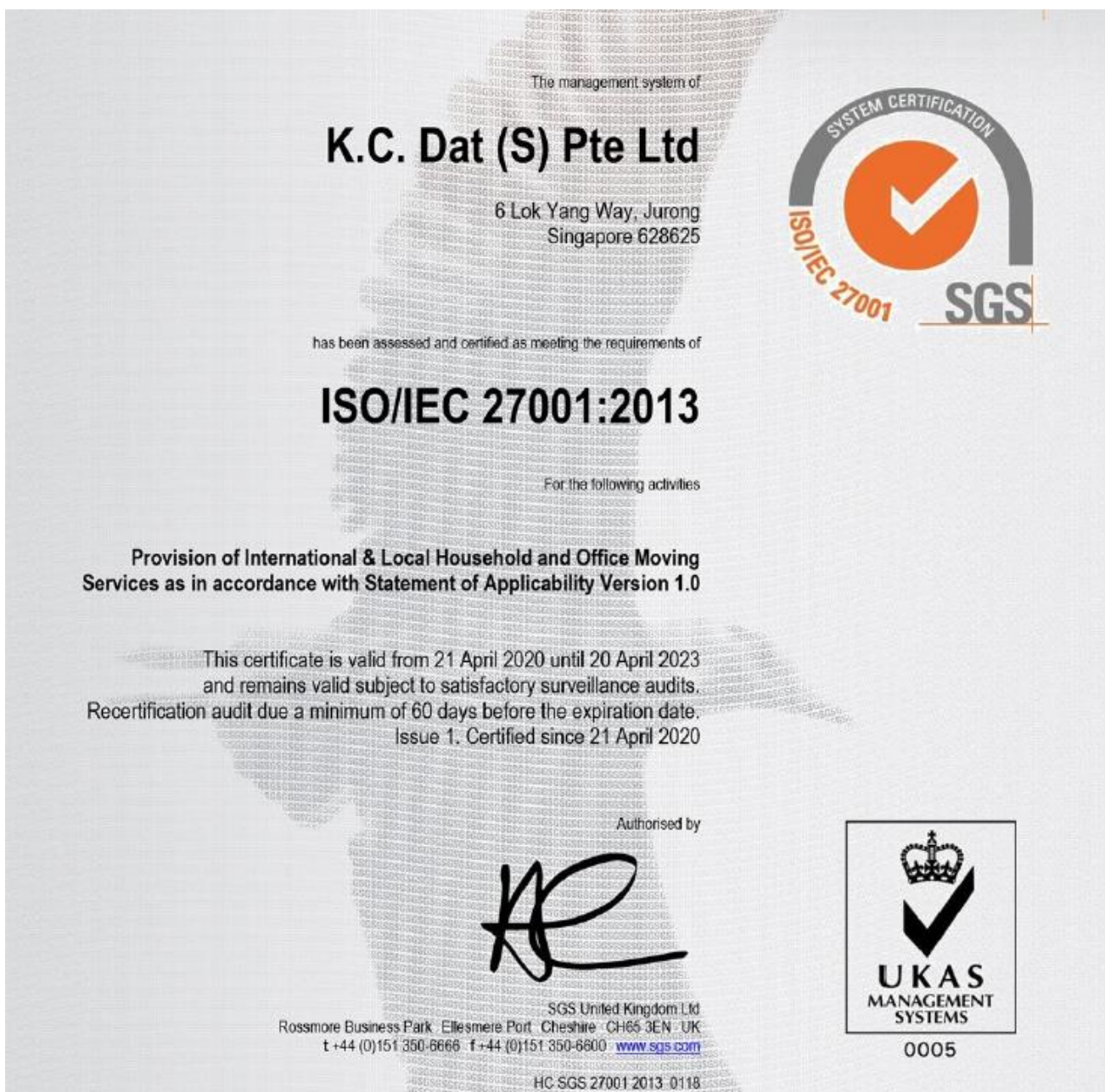

The certification and audit were performed by SGS, the world’s leading inspection, verification, testing and certification company. As our commitment to our valued Clients, Customers and our Supply Chain Partners, we set out on this journey to keep their information and our data safe by implementing ISO/IEC 27001:2013 certification Information Security Management System (ISMS).

Prior to our journey, several Consultancy Firms invited to our RFP came surprised by our intent to pursue ISO/IEC 27001:2013. Our industry was just not amongst the businesses they will expect to see.
